This method is greyhat... VERY greyhat. So greyhat in fact that I felt bad about doing it – however, you definitely can make money with it, as I'm proof that it works.

The best part is that it only takes twenty minutes of work to set this up, and I'm not joking. After the setup, it takes five seconds daily... to check how much you have earned.

I am going to show you an exact method I used – you can expand this for any offer.

a) Use a good affiliate program. I recommend NeverBlue Ads (they will call you to verify) however you can also use any affiliate program of your choosing.

b) Pick a good offer that pays well per signup. In my case, I used Bidz which pays \$7/lead.

c) Setup a Gmail Account. It is better that you use one that looks realistic, fake of course – something like <u>FirstName.LastName83@gmail.com</u> d) Purchase a domain. For example, if you choose to promote the Bidz offer, you might purchase bidzonline.com or bidzauctions.com. Create an email address for it – jobs@yourrelateddomain.com and add it to your Gmail account (Setting \Box Accounts). Set this new email as your main email in Gmail.

If you use GoDaddy, the domain will cost \$7.15 (slightly more than one conversion) with the coupon code OYH3.

Also, redirect the domain to your offer affiliate link.

And guess what? The best part STARTS HERE.

e) Go to job sites, for example see below.

Post something like this: (do not copy word for word)

Hello,

We are looking for writers for our jewelry auction website. You will need to create short (20 - 25 word) write ups of daily auctions. We will pay \$0.01/word to startup, then increase if it goes well. You MUST be interested in jewelry to take up the job.

Due to payment issues, we can only take writers that are based in the USA for now. Please send an email to <u>YourNewGmailAcc@Gmail.com</u> to apply if you fit_the criteria.

Thank You, Your (Fake) Name

I recommend the first one as it doesn't require anything to post, just a free account. Posts will go pending first, and then live after 1-2 days.

e) Go to the Gmail account you setup. Under settings, there will be a thing called Vacation autoresponder, I believe hotmail as a similar setting.

Write something like:

Hello,

Thank you for your interest. At the moment, we have received lots of interested parties, so are going through the applications. Please signup at our website below and take a look around, as that will make things quicker should we hire you.

<u>www.bidzonline.com</u> (for example__I believe _ this_domain is still available).

Thank you,

Your (Fake) Name

Nearly every single person you reply to will signup.

You will get a crazy amount of emails. Just take a look at my screenshot.

All of those emails came within a week. USA, job hungry.

I only replied to around twenty five, and had almost all of them signup, netting me \$140 in revenue after three days and a short while of work to setup the above steps. If you use Online Writing Jobs, your only spend is the domain.

I strongly suggest you find a different offer, or not use Bidz on Online Writing Jobs as I have already done so. I did not promote at any other job website though, so there is a lot open for you to target.

Rewrite the email and your job ads (but make them similar to the ones above) to gain maximum success.

You can try this with any kind of pay per signup offer – USA ones tend to pay well. The good thing is that you are sending targeted visitors (only people that like jewelry, for example) to the signup so there is a high chance a few of them will stay on giving you a good conversion rate.
