Goo's Ebay Bomb

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WELCOME TO THE BOMB!

This is a very indepth guide into a simple method! So, let's get started!

WHAT YOU'RE GOING TO NEED:

- A new PayPal account
- A new Ebay account
- A VCC <- Important
- And 3 days...

How much will you make with this, you ask? You'll make AS MUCH AS YOU WANT! I made \$300 yesterday! That's insane!

Step 1: Get each of the things listed above. It's important you have all of these so you can get paid, list the thing that you'll be getting paid with, and link the place you get paid to the place you listed the "item." I say "item," not because we're going to scam them, but... you'll see!

Step 2: Go research some items! As long as it's below \$1K, you're good. I usually go with an iPhone 5s. A tip to find an item: search it, then click "sold listings." If there's a recent one, bingo. If not, keep searching!

Step 3: Click "Sell." In this example, I'm going to sell an "iPhone." Again, quotes. So, my title would be:

"BRAND NEW iPHONE 5s {Carrier} {Color} GUIDE NEWEST MODEL!"

Look closely at that title. Here it is again, one more time:

"BRAND NEW iPHONE 5s {Carrier} {Color} <u>**GUIDE**</u> NEWEST MODEL!" Ah, yes. We're not going to sell them a phone! We're selling them a guide on how to get that phone! So, in the description, make sure, at the SMALLEST SIZE POSSIBLE, you type, "This is a(n) {item name} buying guide." Then, in somewhat large, not too large text, explain features. Don't say they're getting a phone! So, just say "The new iPhone 5s has a beautiful Retina Display!" and "It also features the brand new TouchID sensor!" Make it look like a sales pitch. At the bottom, in smaller text, say "No returns, chargebacks, or anything of that nature!" Make sure it's listed under the proper category, too! iPhone guides should be listed under "Cell Phones and Accessories, Cell Phone Accessories" Include a high quality picture of what you're selling. Select a non-specific shipping choice, then go ahead and click "Free Shipping!" Make sure it's on Buy it Now or best offer, and only a 3 day listing!

Step 4: List that baby! Put it out to the world! Wait 3-5 hours, come back, see if anyone is watching/bought it. If they made an offer, accept it! If they bought it and paid for it, skip to Step 6. If they haven't, read on.

Step 5: Aww... They didn't pay? Not to worry! You won't have to pay a fee on the item. Give it 2 days, if they haven't paid, open an unpaid item case! Wait 3 more, then close it! Bam! Credits for future fees! Now, relist it!

Step 6: Nice! You got paid! Now, tell them how to get the item from the OFFICIAL store! Send it to their PayPal email. Make it look official! They didn't have a problem with it? This is unlikely. Skip to step 8 though if this is true! Charged back or opened a case? Read on!

Step 7: If they opened a case, tell them you told them it's a guide in the listing. They'll flip the hell out on you. I even had one guy say he was from Ebay. Yeah, if they threaten you, call the authorities. That shouldn't be taken lightly, since they have your home address. But, if they persist, call Ebay. They'll deal with it. Not only that. If you get lucky and have a complete idiot buy it and open a case, chose the wrong category, then open another one, YOU INSTANTLY GOT PAID! No waiting 20 days or whatever. Little glitch! :)

Step 8: TRANSFER THE DAMN MONEY!!! NOW!!! They still could chargeback. Transfer it to your main. Or, you could buy something! That works too. Just get it the hell out of there!
